The U.S. Passport Card can be used to enter the United States from Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean, and Bermuda at land border crossings or sea ports-of-entry and is more convenient and less expensive than a passport book. (**Minors DO NOT have to have a passport or passport card. See below info on traveling with minor.**)
