For those of you who do not know, on the Thursday, July 12 in the evening, Family Campers and RVers, along with "The Barn Dance Society" and the Town of Blyth will sponsor a Benefit program to raise funds to help with planting of new trees in the Town Of Goderich, which is about 15 miles from Blyth, the home of Campvention 2012. The Town of Goderich was hit with a F3 Tornado back in August 2011 and the town's trees suffered greatly. There is an article in Camping Today written by Noreen Smith about the devastation in this small Town. The benefit will cost our organization nothing, but our labour to help co-ordinate the event. The Town of Goderich will co-ordiant the ticket sales and advertising and marketing, The Township of North Huron will staff the arena in Blyth for a major event and the "Barn Dance Society" will perform at a reduced rate. We expect to sell 100 % of the 1300 tickets at a cost of \$20 a ticket. The "Barn Dance Society" performed for us back in 2006 and they will do a second private show for Campvention on July 16th so all of our members will have a chance to see the show as well. We hope that our members will take the opportunity to visit the Town of Goderich when they are at Campvention next summer. There will be more information in an upcoming "Camping Today".
