	SCALE	CATEGORY	CONSIDERATION
A	1 - 10	Membership	Number of years in FCRV - 1 point per year up to maximum of 10.
B	1 - 15	Leadership	Positions held. Length of time in each position. Specify if position was Chapter, Field, District, State Provincial and/or State/Provincial Association.
C	1 - 20	Achievements	What was accomplished while in position listed in B. Include contributions to growth of FCRV on Chapter, State/Provincial level
D	1 - 15	National Service	Same as B...only on the National level as a Trustee, Regional, State/Provincial Director, District, Field, or Program Director, etc. Number of years in each position.
E	1 - 20	National Achievements	Same as C...only on the National level. Include membership recruitment, new chapter organized and formed, outstanding program successes, etc.
F	1 - 10	Community Involvement	Responsibilities and activities other than FCRV (Family, Church, Civic, etc.) time needed for these activities make the time given to FCRV all the more valuable. Consider all organizations including Fraternal, Scouting, 4-H, etc. (Number of years, positions held, years in each, etc.)
G	1 - 10	Special Recognition	Not included above. The “extra Mile”. Why this nominee is deserving of a National Award. Dedication, number of Campventions attended, etc.

NOTE:

1. The Awards Committee has the decision and privilege to make the appropriate award based on the information submitted. After the committee has evaluated each nomination and determined the total number of points for each, the top point recipients will receive plaques. The total number of plaques will not exceed five (5). Up to four (4) plaques *may* be awarded to entries with National Service.

2. If there is a nomination that does not fall into the category of Citations or Plaques, but is worthy of special recognition, it may be given to the President for consideration to receive the special “National President’s Certificate of Appreciation”.

3. Even if members of the Awards Committee know or are friends with a nominee, they are asked to be objective and consider only the information submitted on the form. Personal consideration must be put aside.
