



Recommended Safety Guidelines For Family Campers & RVers Chapters When Children Are Present

These guidelines should be helpful in keeping our children safe when attending chapter functions as well as state, regional and national functions.

1. - **Policy** - All adult members will wear name badges at all FCRV functions. These name tags should include full name and the name of the chapter. All youth, up to and including age 12, should wear wrist bands, containing the same information as the name tags, when attending all FCRV functions. Teens should have their FCRV Teen Cards on their person at all times, at all FCRV functions.
2. If children want to ride their bikes or take a walk around the campground, encourage them to do so in a group of two or more.
3. If an adult who is not the parent or guardian (or grandparent) is supervising a child, be sure to suggest that this be done in view of another adult.
4. During supervised activities, two or more adults (preferably one of the parents, guardians or grandparents of one of the children) should be present.
5. Tell children not to go into anyone's campsite or camping unit without the permission of their parents, guardians or grandparents.
6. Tell children not to go into or play alone in public restrooms (including those in campgrounds).
7. Parents, guardians and grandparents - **KNOW WHERE YOUR CHILDREN ARE AT ALL TIMES.**
8. Tell children not to talk to or go anywhere with anyone they do not know.
9. Tell children that if they are approached by someone they do not know to tell their parent, guardian or grandparent about the incident immediately.
